

Gold Bead Acupuncture in Canine Orthopedic Cases

Introduction and summary of the course content

Gold Bead Acupuncture has been playing an important role in relieving pain in veterinary orthopedic conditions for more than 30 years. This treatment is very safe and minimally invasive if performed properly and longterm pain relief is readily achieved.

After finishing the course the participants will be able to treat hip, elbow, stifle and spinal conditions in their own praxis.

There are a number of different ways to treat the pain due to arthrosis with gold beads. This course is based on Traditional Chinese Veterinary Medicine and participants must have good knowledge of Traditional Chinese Veterinary Medicine (TCVM).

At the beginning of the course there is a review of how to examine a dog to get a “western” diagnosis followed by a summary about pain and Bi-syndrome in TCVM.

First, the general principles of the Gold Bead Acupuncture are discussed in detail, the indications, the contraindications, the preparation of the patient, the fundamentals of the procedure and the expected results.

This is followed by a detailed discussion of the treatment of the hips, elbows, spine and stifles.

At the end of the course the participants should be able to practice Gold Bead Acupuncture in their own clinic in a safe and successful way.

The course fee (750,- € for IVAS/GERVAS members, 900,-€ for others) includes lunch, coffee breaks and notes.

This course can only take place with a minimum of attendants and is limited to a maximum of 8 delegates enrolled in order of registration.
